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- 1 – Legal Methods II will meet for 14 weeks.
- 2 - Course satisfies the Mission-Related Course requirement. Students who entered the College of Law in Fall 2010 or later must satisfy this requirement prior to graduation.
- 3 – Business Organizations is the prerequisites for Business Planning.
- 4 – There are no restrictions on enrollment in this course. The restrictions listed in the course description have been waived.
- 5 – Enrollment in this course is limited to students who are eligible to graduate in May 2012, August 2012 or December 2012.
- 6 – Evidence is the prerequisite for Pretrial Practice Workshop.
- 7 – Evidence is the prerequisite for Trial Practice.
- 8 - This class will be held off-site at the Orange County Courthouse in courtroom 10D
- 9 – **ONLY** Seminars and Independent Research Projects satisfy the Upper-Level Writing Requirement.
- 10 - This course will appear in iRattler after a course number is assigned.
- 11 - Students may not withdraw from clinics after the end of the Add/Drop period.
- 12 - Students enrolling in a clinic must attend a mandatory orientation on January 9, 2012 at 5:00 p.m. in conference Room 184, Meeting days and times for clinics other than Homelessness clinic will be determined at the orientaion meeting.
- 13 - Registration by application and permission **ONLY**. To register, student must complete two steps. First, the student must submit an approved outline and application signed by the professor who will supervise and evaluate the research paper. Second, students must submit the signed application to Associate Dean Cooper for final approval. The supervising faculty member must be a member of the full-time faculty who does not teach in the Legal Methods Program or in the Academic Success Program. Obtain the application form from the Registrar's Office or the from the College of Law website. The completed application **MUST** be submitted to Associate Dean Cooper no later than the **FIRST DAY OF CLASSES**.  
LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE APPROVED. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 14 - The non-credit Academic Success classes do not appear in iRattler. There is no registration for the Academic Success classes.
- 15 – Highly recommended academic skills course for all entering first year students. Classes begin Wednesday, January 25, 2012. This class meets weekly from January 25, 2012 through April 16, 2012.
- 16 – Highly recommended academic skills course for all second year part-time students as well as other upper-level students who are available during the class meeting time.  
Classes begin Thursday, February 2, 2012. **This class meets every Thursday from February 2, 2012 through April 12, 2012. This class will not meet on March 1, 2012 & March 8, 2012.**
